Leeds Arts Council Art Gallery

The Leeds Arts Council (LAC) owns and operates the Leeds Theatre & Arts Center. Each month, LAC exhibits works by various artists. We bring to the community a variety of styles, media, and subjects. Participation is by invitation of the LAC Visual Arts Chair. Although LAC encourages all artists in every phase of growth, LAC permits only quality, non-controversial art to be shown under its sponsorship.

Rules for Exhibitors

Placing or hanging your work in the gallery of LAC's Theatre & Arts Center is considered evidence that you accept the following rules and requirements:

- 1. To hold LAC and its members harmless from loss or damage to art work and for personal injury that may occur due to your participation in LAC sponsored/arranged shows.
- 2. To exhibit only your own original work. Up to 25% of the exhibit may be prints of your original work; however, they must be identified as prints on the attached card. We do not allow patterns, kits (including paint-by-number), or stencils. We do not allow work done in art classes unless it is entirely your own work. We do not allow copies of copyrighted material such as newspapers, magazines, and postcards without attached information stating that the painting is a copy.
- 3. To have at least 75% of the work available for purchase. If the frames are not included in the purchase price, this must be stated on the attached cards.
- 4. To exhibit work in a quality manner. Framed work must be in neat, good quality frames. The back must be appropriately finished with wire attached for hanging. Frames should be dust free and the glass clean.
- 5. To meet community standards of decency. Leeds is a small, conservative community. LAC sponsors only family-oriented events; therefore, we do not allow nudity, sexual innuendo, sacrilegious subject matter, or any work that could be considered controversial or offensive. If there is any question concerning the acceptability of the work, the artist agrees to remove the work immediately. This is at the Visual Arts chair's discretion based on his/her personal decision or at the instruction of LAC's Board of Directors and the decision is final.
